Itinerary

Heartbeats of Africa is looking forward to showing you around South Africa in the areas of Kruger National Park with your host and photographer guide Heike.

Together we will make your expedition a memorable one with lots of opportunities to photograph wildlife in its natural habitat.



DAY 1 - 4:

We will depart from Johannesburg at 08:00 a.m. in the morning, and make the $\pm$ 4.5 hour drive to Kruger National Park. On arrival we will have a afternoon safari while slowly making our way to Olifants Rest Camp in the Northern part of the park.

On day 2 & 3 we will spend mornings and afternoons on safari with a lunch break in some of the rest camps.

During the drives we will be spotting as many wildlife as possible and visiting all the hotspots .

On day 4 we will head closer to centre of Kruger to the next destination, Skukuza Camp

DAY 4 - 7:

On day 4 we depart for the more centred area of Kruger National Park.

This will be an early start to go out to the next destination, Skukuza Camp.

Here we will continue to explore the central Eastern and Western areas of Kruger using our camp as the base for our morning and afternoon game drives, doing a lunch break in between the safaris.

DAY 7 - 10

On day 7 we will head out on Safari early as always, have a short break for Breakfast and move down to the south.

Here we will check in to Pestana Kruger Lodge located just outside of the National Park.

Exploring the most Southern part of Kruger on Morning and Afternoon drives with lunch breaks will continue until, on day 10 we will head back to Johannesburg.
